



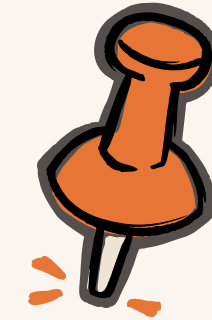
Understanding Paper Tubes

Layers wrapped parallel for precision applications.

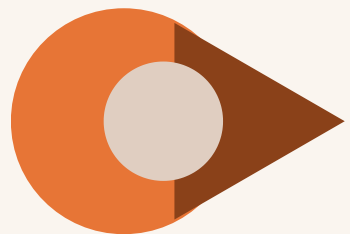


Common Applications

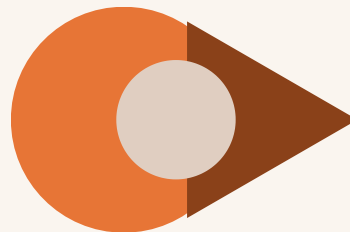
- Packaging – Used for shipping posters, documents, and fragile items.

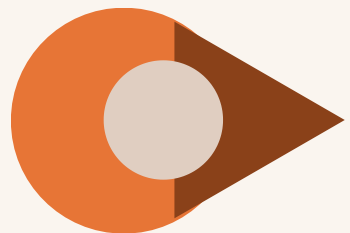
